A. Independent Living Facility Project Update 8:45 am A Fleck

We are still working to get the ILF Project into the innovations funding RFP process. There was a brief recap of the project.

B. Depression Screening 9:15 am K Judd/N Constantino/

N Constantino reported to the group that a meeting was held and the format of the Depression Screening Days is as follows

- Will be using a new screening tool the PHQ-9
- Regular meeting dates will be the 1st Wednesday of the month at API, 7200 Pkwy Drive, La Mesa, CA. Next meeting is August 4th.

Action Item: A Fleck to check with Suicide Prevention COTR to see if there might be media funding to promote the week and the activities and possibly for translation of materials.

It was mentioned that there is a 30-minute video that should be playing in the background at the depression screening events.

Action Item: R Covell and/or L Kruidenier to contact Sue Schultz (spelling?) to see about the possibility of getting them donated for the event.

There was talk about the County possibly not being able to do a press event around depression screenings this year. Perhaps CHIP can do it if the County is not able?

C. HELP Connection Book 9:30 am R Covell

This committee has met once and there is enthusiastic about moving the project ahead in a way that minimizes staff participation. Jim D mentioned that UBH (Optum Health) uses the book all the time and would help play a role in data collection & update

Need to take a look at whether or not we will print copies or just make it available electronically. The group was reminded that there is currently no budget for this project and any funding would need to be raised by the group.

A. HHSA Health Strategy Agenda Update

B. Suicide Prevention Action Plan Grant and Work Team Update

- A chart from the up and coming Suicide in San Diego County Report update was shared. This preliminary data showed that suicide is back to the #2 leading cause of non-natural death in San Diego county.
- Harder & Company has been selected as the contractors on the project
- There will be a communitywide kickoff event on July 14th from 8am-12pm at the Hilton on Mission Bay.
