III. BHWT Sub-Committee Updates 8:40 am All

A. Independent Living Facility Project (ILFP) Update 8:45 am A Fleck

A Carrillo presented at the last MH Board meeting which focused on housing. There was a discussion on the reduction of Board and Care facilities (110 → 76-78) and beds (1375 → 1170) in the past two years. Everyone at the meeting was receptive and engaged and they will vote next month about casting official support for the ILFP. In addition, Carrillo has been receiving calls of support.

R Gibbs is already training classes, on her own, for facility owners. The first training will be on bed bugs. These are designed to give the community a taste of the up and coming trainings for the ILFP and to start building relationships within the ILF community.

i. Letters of Support

The County of San Diego Innovations funding is taking a little longer than first anticipated and the process has changed slightly. We should continue to receive letters of support. A Fleck presented a listing of the letters of support received to date.

In addition, we have held conversations with other community groups, programs and organizations who may have an interest in the topic, e.g. PTECH, The Monger Group (homeless focus).
